

RULES

‘MURCIA VS REST OF THE WORLD’ Tournament - 28 February 2026

1. PARTICIPANTS

All players with a valid license issued by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation are eligible to participate.

The players will be divided into two teams:

* Murcia Team

* Rest of the World Team

The organizers will assign each player to a team based on criteria such as date of birth, place of residence or other sporting criteria.

2. REGISTRATION

Registration will be managed through the Murcia Region Golf Federation website using the GolfDirecto application:

Required information: first name, surname (s), license number, email address and telephone number.

The registration period will close 48 hours before the start of the competition or earlier if the maximum number of participants is reached. Any subsequent registrations will be placed on a waiting list.

3. DATE, LOCATION AND FEE

The competition will be held exclusively on:

28 February 2026

El Valle Golf

9:00 a.m.

4. OFFICIAL LUNCH

At the end of the competition, all players will enjoy the official lunch at:

El Valle Golf Restaurant

5. CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- * The competition will be played under the rules of golf of the RFEG and the local rules of the course.
- * The playing handicap will be calculated as 95% of the exact handicap.
- * Players with a handicap greater than 36 may participate, but will be limited to 36.
- * The use of distance measuring devices is permitted.
- * Tee times and rankings will be published on www.fgolfmurcia.com and on the GolfDirecto app.
- * No complaints will be accepted more than 24 hours after the publication of the rankings.

6. FORMAT

The competition will be played in the following format:

Individual Stableford

7. TEAM COMPETITION SYSTEM

The tournament pits Murcia against the Rest of the World.

Each player plays her round individually, but her points count towards her team.

Final team score = Average of the Stableford points obtained by all participating players.

The team with the highest average Stableford points will win the tournament.

This is a balanced system that avoids advantages due to a greater or lesser number of players.

8. TEE BOXES

- * Red, in accordance with course regulations for women's competition.

9. PRIZES

At the end of the competition, the following prizes will be awarded:

- * First and second place in each category.
- * Special Scratch prize.
- * Winning team: Murcia / Rest of the World

The awards ceremony will take place at the club after lunch.

- NEAREST TO PIN

- LONGEST DRIVE

10. INDIVIDUAL TIEBREAKERS

* The Green Book procedure will be applied.

* If the tie persists:

1. Lowest playing handicap.

2. Calculation of the last 9, 12, 15, 16 and 17 holes, if the round is 18 holes.
